- Woodlands Camp was founded in 1997 near the foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains in Cleveland, GA
- Over the last 25+ years, Woodlands has grown from 150 to 10,000 campers per summer
- As a result of God's faithfulness, we've seen over 4,500 kids put their trust in Jesus for the first time at camp
- Our program has become highly sought after by churches and campers alike
- The mobile day camp model is a new program that allows us to take everything we've learned in 25+ years of camp ministry and share it with you and your community

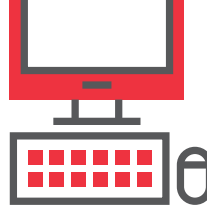
Freestyle Overview

- Kids will experience engaging Bible lessons and unforgettable activities led by Woodlands staff members
- Activities include: large group games, 9-square, gaga ball, obstacle course, rock climb slide, giant water slide, slip-n-slide, and camp store
- Day camp runs Monday-Friday, 9am-4pm
- Any kids that have completed K-5th grade can register
- The cost of each week is \$225 per camper
- Camper to counselor ratio is 8:1
- Max Capacity of each team is 200, with options of combining up to 3 teams
- The minimum number of campers is 75



Why is Day Camp Important?

- Kids spend 7-9 hours a day connected to a device
- This generation is the most biblically illiterate generation ever
- Camp is one of the few places that kids can disconnect from technology

Volunteer Opportunities

Host Homes

Our staff of 25 per Freestyle team needs a place to stay. Host families open up their homes for the week and provide beds, fellowship, breakfast, and dinners. This is the best way to stay connected with what is going on during the week.

Meal Prep

Help prepare and serve lunches to our staff and volunteers during the week so we can be all-in during meal times.

Medical Professional

For safety reasons, we require that every site have a medical professional (preferably a nurse) in case of camper medical needs.

Staff Gathering Host

Once or twice a week, our staff gathers together for fun, fellowship, and teaching.

Monday Morning Registrar

Help campers check in as they arrive for their week of camp.

Specialty Volunteers

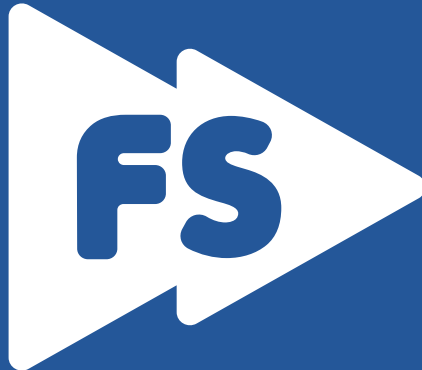
